Subject: Certificate Application

Those wishing to start a taxicab company within Clark County must make application to the State of Nevada Taxicab Authority. The initial application packet presently costs \$20.00 and may be picked up at the Taxicab Authority Offices.

The packet contains all the necessary information, instructions and forms the applicant will need. Sections of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 706 pertaining to the ownership of a taxicab company are also included in the packet.

After completing the application, the applicant must return the original application, nine (9) copies of the application and all exhibits to the Taxicab Authority Office to be filed. The filing fee is \$200.00. This is non-refundable.

Upon receipt of the application, the Taxicab Authority notifies interested and/or affected parties through the press by paid publication allowing approximately thirty (30) days for protests to be filed with the Taxicab Authority. Then a Public Hearing will be noticed and held by the Taxicab Authority.

The applicant will be responsible for the total cost of the Administrative process. The cost includes all transportation, food and lodging, plus an hourly charge for the time expended by the agent or agents assigned to the application. Before the background investigation can begin, the applicant must provide a deposit of half of the estimated administrative process. An hourly expense will be charged at \$25.00 per hour for the time expended while the agent(s) are engaged in the actual investigation process.

The entire process can take anywhere from six months to one year.
